## The John Young Scholarship in the Arts 2010 Spring Award Application Form

The purpose of *The John Young Scholarship in the Arts* is to provide assistance to up to 7 undergraduate juniors or seniors and up to 7 graduate students enrolled in the Colleges of Arts & Sciences and pursuing a degree in any field related to the arts (e.g. fine arts, music, dance, theater, literature, art history, creative media). These awards are made possible by The John Young Foundation to honor the late renowned artist, John Young, and to fulfill his wish to support students of the arts at the University of Hawai'i at Mānoa.

Graduate awards are \$6,000 each. Undergraduate awards are \$3,000 each.

### Eligibility (applicable to Spring 2010 semester)

- Classified Arts & Sciences graduate student pursuing a degree in any field related to the arts OR undergraduate junior or senior with a declared Arts & Sciences major in a field related to the arts
- Graduate of a Hawai'i high school (applies to undergraduates only)
- Preference given to graduates of a Hawai'i high school (applies to graduate students only)
- Some degree of financial need
- In good academic standing at the University of Hawai'i at Mānoa

### Application Procedure

To apply, student must submit **5 copies of this application form and the attachments** (described below) to: Office of Community & Alumni Relations, Colleges of Arts & Sciences, University of Hawai'i at Mānoa, 2500 Campus Road, Hawai'i Hall 311, Honolulu, HI 96822, phone (808) 956-4051. The application must be complete and in the aforementioned office by **4:00 p.m. October 29, 2009**. Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.

Finalists may be asked to participate in an on-campus interview by the selection committee and provide a sample talent (e.g., photos of artwork; video/audiotape; portfolio; writing sample) at the interview.

1. This completed application form as the cover sheet for each of the 5 packets.
2. Current **official** University transcript (original + 4 copies must be included in this packet. Do **NOT** have transcript sent to office, and do **NOT** use unofficial on-line transcript from the Banner System).
3. 1,000-word essay discussing your career goals and your intended contributions to the field of arts.
4. One-page letter of recommendation from a professor describing artwork, talent, and potential of student. Advise your professor to place the original letter + 4 copies in **ONE** sealed envelope.

**Do not submit more material than what is requested above.**

**Application Deadline: 4:00 p.m. October 29, 2009.** Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.
