The Colleges of Arts & Sciences Alumni Association Rodney P. Santos Scholarship 2010 Spring Award Application Form

Rodney P. Santos, retired educator and founding member and former president of the Colleges of Arts & Sciences Alumni Association (CASAA), established a scholarship fund to encourage undergraduate students in their pursuit of a liberal arts education. Up to five (5) students will receive cash awards of \$1,000 each to assist them with their education expenses.

CASAA was established in 1993 to “serve as a valuable link between the Colleges and the community in promoting awareness and appreciation of, and pride in, the lifetime value of a liberal arts education obtained from the University of Hawai’i at Mānoa.”

Eligibility (applicable to Spring 2010 semester)

- be a graduate of a Hawai’i high school;
- be a full-time junior or senior at UH Mānoa with a declared Arts and Sciences major;
- have a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.5;
- have some degree of financial need; and
- have already received or intend to receive 50% of the undergraduate degree requirements from UH Mānoa.

Application Procedure

To apply, student must submit **3 copies of this application form and the attachments** (described below) to: Office of Community & Alumni Relations, Colleges of Arts & Sciences, University of Hawai’i at Mānoa, 2500 Campus Road, Hawai’i Hall 311, Honolulu, HI 96822, phone (808) 956-4051. The application must be complete and in the aforementioned office by **4:00 p.m. on October 29, 2009**. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered. (Finalists may be asked to participate in an on-campus interview by the selection committee).

3. Current **official** University transcript (original + 2 copies must be included in this packet, do **NOT** have transcript sent to office, and do **NOT** use unofficial on-line transcript from the Banner System).
4. Letter of recommendation from a professor in your major. Advise your professor to place original letter + 2 copies in **ONE** sealed envelope.

Do not submit more material than what is requested above.

Application Deadline: 4:00 p.m. October 29, 2009. Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.
