The purpose of the Jhamandas Watumull Arts & Sciences Scholarship is to recognize and assist meritorious seniors in the Colleges of Arts & Sciences. Recipient must use the award for expenses associated with attending the university.

1 award of approximately \$2,500 will be made (depending upon availability of funds).

Eligibility (applicable to Spring 2010 semester)

- be a full-time undergraduate student at the University of Hawai'i at Mānoa majoring in an Arts & Sciences discipline
- have senior academic standing
- have a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA
- preference will be given to students born and raised in India who have either directly or recently arrived at the University of Hawai'i at Mānoa from India (documented proof will be required).

Application Procedure

The application must be complete and in the aforementioned office by **4:00 p.m. on October 29, 2009**. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered. (Finalists may be asked to participate in an on-campus interview by the selection committee).

4. Letter of recommendation by a faculty member who can attest to your scholarship. Advise your faculty member to place original letter + 2 copies in **ONE** sealed envelope.
