# ***HANDS OF HOPE SCHOLARSHIPS***

The College of Arts and Humanities is pleased to announce the Hands of Hope Scholarships. These scholarships are made possible by the Hands of Hope Foundation, a local organization that supports the youth of Hawai'i. **Two \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded for spring 2010.**

**To be eligible for a *Hands of Hope* scholarship, the applicant must:**

- be a **currently enrolled, full-time undergraduate student at UH Mānoa** with a **declared major in American Studies, History, Philosophy, Religion, or Speech;**
- be in good academic standing at UH-Mānoa with a minimum 3.0 GPA;
- have some degree of financial need.
- Preference will be given to state of Hawai'i residents

**To apply, submit 4 copies of your application packet. Each application packet must contain the following (in order):**

- *Cover sheet* which lists: (1) your name, (2) current mailing address, (3) permanent mailing address, (4) telephone number, (5) number of years you have been a resident of Hawai'i, (6) email address, (7) social security number, (8) UH ID number, (9) college major, (10) accumulated GPA at UH Mānoa, and (11) the number of credits hours taken in each of the last two years at UH Mānoa
- *Letter of recommendation* from a UHM College of Arts and Humanities faculty member in your major (original letter + 3 copies)
- *Official current UHM transcript* (official transcript + 3 copies)
- *Statement of financial need and scholarly achievement* (maximum two pages)
- *Personal Statement* describing your involvement in school or community service (maximum two pages)
